

DOCUMENT STATUS

Comments were received from the agencies on two documents since the May RAB meeting. The documents currently under review by the agencies include:

- Draft Investigation Area H1 Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Closure Certification Report
- Draft Investigation Area H1 Post-Closure Permit Application/Post-Closure Care Plan

The following documents are being updated by Weston to incorporate responses to agency comments:

- Draft Final Remedial Investigation Report for IR Site 05/Dredge Pond 7S/Western Magazine Area
- Draft IR Site 05 Time Critical Removal Action Completion Report
- Draft Investigation Area H1 CERCLA Remedial Action Completion Report

IR SITE 05 DATA GAPS SAMPLING

Soil samples were collected on July 2nd at five locations within IR05 that were identified as data gaps by Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) during their review of the Draft Final Remedial Investigation (RI) report for IR05. Results will be incorporated into the Final version of the RI report currently being prepared.

IR SITE 05 WETLANDS RESTORATION PROGRESS

Five acres within IR Site 05 previously excavated to remove contaminants were backfilled to establish a muted tidal environment to encourage the development of pickleweed-dominated wetland habitat. The wetlands will be

monitored for five years or longer to verify that the wetland restoration criteria have been achieved. These criteria include a 95% native wetland plant density with at least 60% pickleweed. This is the first season since grading of the site was completed last fall, along with planting of pickleweed cuttings. The photos below indicate that pickleweed is beginning to reestablish itself within the graded area. Non-natives will be monitored and removed as necessary to achieve the restoration criteria.
